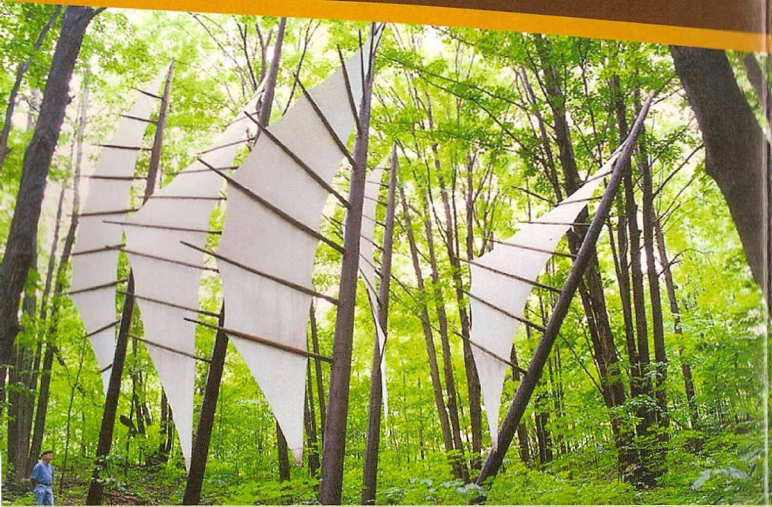

**Hike** a 1.6-mile trail that winds through a 30-acre preserve of wooded hills; **discover** more than 40 extraordinary works of art; **climb** to a lookout atop a French Fort and see inspiring vistas; **contemplate** the complexities of history, environment and cultural identity; **listen** to a performance at the amphitheatre.

**Visit often** to discover new art, reflect on its meaning and enjoy the natural beauty of Northern Michigan!

**Michigan Legacy Art Park began in 1995 under the artistic direction and vision of sculptor David Barr to tell the stories of Michigan's history and culture through outdoor sculpture.**

## Michigan Legacy Art Park



**Michigan Legacy Art Park is located at Crystal Mountain in Benzie County.**

**From Cadillac** (39 miles):

Crystal is 39 miles NW of Cadillac on M-115.

**From Manistee** (28 miles):

21 miles north on US-31. Turn east on County Road 602, then 7 miles to M-115. Turn west to Crystal's entrance.

**From Traverse City** (28 miles):

Take US-31 south to Thompsonville Rd. (County Rd. 669, 10 miles past Interlochen). Follow County Rd. 669 south to Thompsonville. Turn right at blinking light, 2 miles to Crystal.

**From Grand Rapids** (130 miles):

Take US-131 north to Cadillac, exit M-115 west. Crystal is 39 miles NW of Cadillac on M-115.
